Objectives

GDPR guidelines imposes significant requirements on "data controllers" and "data processors" within the EU, as well as such organizations located outside the EU if the organizations: (1) offer goods and services to persons in the EU; or (2) monitor behavior of individuals in the EU.

The guidelines, in part, further clarify which entities are considered within the EU and which entities that, while located outside the EU, are nevertheless subject to the GDPR.
