### Introduction

Cloud computing is not new, but the standard, work process, roles and responsibilities in cloud computing are evolving. Thus, new risks emerge.

To understand the changes and risks when an IT department adopts cloud computing is becoming a crucial work for IT security and Compliance executives. With the extensive uses of public cloud like Azure and AWS, cloud auditing is now part of the controls of any IT audits.

In Cloud Computing, the IT department asset list is no longer just servers or firewalls inside data centre. Cloud computing platforms offer IP address, public/private keys, storage, database, firewall, VPN etc. Your cloud computing infrastructure is becoming a growing list of virtual assets. Traditional asset management process may not fit.

The efficient way to manage cloud asset is the first step in IT audit planning on cloud platforms. This seminar will give you a heads-up on this very first step.
